What does AWANA stand for, and what is it?

Awana stands for **Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed**.

2 Timothy 2:15 states "Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of God".

Awana helps churches and parents work together to develop spiritually strong children and youth who faithfully follow Jesus Christ.

What will my child do during Awana?

Children meet for an hour and a half once a week throughout the school year. During this time children work on verse memorization, learn about discipleship and evangelism, worship God through music and prayer, as well as have fun with team building games and positive adult reinforcement!

Who else will be in my child's Awana Class?

Rockford Area Awana is divided by three large group ages:

Cubbies - A two year pre-school program for children that will be entering Kindergarten in two years.

Sparks – A three year program, kindergarten, first and second grades.

Truth & Training – A four year, 3rd through 6th grade program. There is a separate club for boys and girls.

Children may also be further separated by grade. This ensures that small group leaders are able to provide guidance and teaching to all club members.

Who will be working with my child?

Awana staff are caring parents, adults, and older youth in the community. We ask that all our staff consent to a background check and require that when working with children individually there is always a second leader or staff member present. We also ask that all our club members are potty trained before joining Awana.

What does the Awana club fee pay for?

The Awana club fee your child pays is to cover the cost of handbooks, awards, custodial costs, and minimal administration costs. Your child will have the opportunity to purchase a uniform when they earn their handbook. All our leaders, directors, and commanders are volunteer positions and for that we thank them!

Where do I drop off and pick up my child?

We ask that parents sign their children in and out every Awana meeting. This is to ensure that the children are always with a caring responsible adult, as well as making sure your child gets the attendance awards they deserve! Awana starts at 6:00pm and ends at 7:30pm please make every effort to be on time so every meeting can run smoothly and your child will not miss anything. Out of respect for other groups meeting during Awana we ask that you use the [south parking lot](#) (education wing) to drop-off and pick-up your children. Thank You!

What happens if Awana is cancelled due to weather?

If Awana is cancelled due to inclement weather Awana commanders, directors and leaders will notify those parents that requested email or text notifications. Parents that did not specify this will have to contact their child's leader or check the Awana BlogSpot for information regarding cancellations. Commanders will also make every effort to have a cancellation announced through radio and news channels along with the church offices.
