<u>Introduction:</u> What you have in your hands is everything you need to complete confirmation and get confirmed in the next three years. Everything that you need to know and all the references to information are contained in this book. However, there's one catch: in order to complete confirmation, you have to complete everything in this book.

A long time ago, likely while you were a newborn kid and maybe even in another congregation, a bunch of people witnessed you getting baptized. At that time, they made some promises to you. One of those was to help raise you in the faith, passing on what they know so that you can come to your own unique faith in Jesus. So, the responsibility for completing this book and getting confirmed isn't all your responsibility, it's theirs as well. That brings me to another catch: you're going to have to talk to those adults, and serve with those adults, if you want to get everything completed in this book and get confirmed.

That might seem like a really challenging task. But we all think you can do it. In fact, we know you can.....because it is out of the love God showed for us in Jesus Christ, that we'll love you through this confirmation process as well. That means: as the congregation, we'll be there every step of the way! All you have to do is ask!

#### **DIRECTIONS AND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:**

Why do we have to complete this book AND show up weekly to confirmation nights? It may seem like a lot. However, confirmation, like church, is a relational thing. It's not simply being taught a bunch of information. It's about growing in faith together with others. That's what being part of a faith community is all about. Think about it this way, you are helping adults grow in their faith just as much as you are through confirmation!

How do I complete this book? It's pretty simple. 1) you find an adult to discuss or to serve alongside, 2) once you complete the item, have them sign, date, and print their name, and 3) you're done!

Who can sign for the items in my book? Any adult in the congregation EXCEPT for anyone living inside your house with you. We do prefer that you reach out to a variety of adults to complete this: having only 1-2 adults sign everything may get you completed, but you won't get much out of it either.

How long do I have to complete this? Just like regular confirmation, this book is designed to be completed by the end of your 9<sup>th</sup> grade year. You can complete it earlier if you'd like. However, if it takes you longer for whatever reason, that's ok too. You'll get confirmed when you complete it!

So do I have to attend the weekly confirmation nights then? Technically, you don't have to attend any of the nights. However, the confirmation nights will be organized to help you complete some of the items by showing up. Also, those nights are designed to help you experience what God and church is all about: community and relationships!!!!

What else do I need to know? When you were baptized, did you know that God placed a claim on you, and that no matter what you do or say, God has chosen to love you unconditionally in Jesus Christ? Confirmation is a time to explore just what it means that this relationship with God and Christ exists, and you did nothing to make it so! This is also a time, not so much to find out what you believe, but also how you will reflect on, challenge, and affirm those beliefs for the rest of your life.

<u>Steps</u>: In order to complete each topic, follow these steps.

- 1. Set up a time to meet with an adult and let them know which topics you'd like to discuss. That way, they can prepare a bit.
- 2. Follow the directions for each topic, making sure to have any references or materials ahead of time and bring them to your meeting.
- 3. Have a discussion about the topic.
- 4. Have the adult sign, print their name, and date the line showing you completed the topic.
