2023 Call Committee July Update

The Call Committee has completed the first of our requirements in submitting the Ministry Site Profile (MSP) to the Synod. On June 21, the Call Committee, Council and members of the Congregation met with Bishop Ann Svennungson to review the MSP and discuss information to help the Synod team select candidates for our consideration. We now await for those candidate names to be supplied to us.

We will interview each of the candidates and then select an individual that in careful deliberation will best serve our congregation. We will present the Final Candidate to the Council for their consideration and approval. After the Council approves the candidate, a call will be offered to the Final Candidate.

I have listed some of the dates and completed Milestones below. Below that are Milestones yet to be completed. After the Candidate accepts the call, the candidate will be installed as our new Pastor. However, please take a look at the last Milestone. This is where our Congregation work begins! It will be up to us to welcome and grow our new Pastor into the position here at Our Father's and also into our wonderful community.

Rockford Neighborhood Night Out Tuesday, August 1, 2023


Let's use the power of our members to support our neighbors by building relationships and community.

Opened in prayer- in attendance Wendy Gustafson, Shannon Sand, Jill Madsen, Lauren Johnson, Dan Schiller, Jody Bryant

Internal Ministries:

Building & Grounds update from John Gilb (present)

Discussion of need for update to siding/roof/windows

Encouraged council & John to work with NH board to begin discussion regarding updating exterior along with addressing potential space needs for NourishingHOPE.

Discussion to work with NourishingHOPE committee to look into a fence to conceal distribution supplies. John to work with Brittni to discuss options.

- Looking for volunteers to help John with building upkeep including pest prevention. Reminder that there is a tab on the website to submit building concerns
- John to collect quotes for parking lot resurfacing/striping and report back to council.

Discussion of church doors/office keys and people with access and ways to balance security and access. Wendy and Shannon to work with Melissa.

Feedback on interim period

Generally, things are running smoothly. Discussion re: ongoing challenges with livestream. Will look into Youtube vs Zoom with paid coverage and accessibility. Continue to work on audio for ongoing audio issues. Wendy is actively seeking volunteers to help with this.

Nourishing Hope-

Encourages volunteers to sign up ahead of time when possible. Continues to have high needs for boxes.

Interim Period

Ministry Site Profile (Wayne Olfert present)

Council approved Ministry Site Profile with one change to a reference pending candidates agreement.

Council approved submitting MSP to the Synod and scheduling meeting with the Bishop.

Interim Pastor- Wendy is in contact with 2 interim candidates and will schedule interviews to fill this role.

Council approved seeking a part time pastor.

Discussion on hourly pay approved. Estimate of weekly needs at 10 hours/ week.

Funerals- Peggy Kennedy- service held 6/3 Sarah Zender presided.

Curt Enger – service to be held 6/17 Sarah Zender will preside.

Baptisms – on hold pending return calls from families that had previously requested them.

Finance:

- Treasurer update to be posted in weekly bulletin. Encourage increases in giving as we move into the summer months. Promote the YETI campaign for increases in automated online giving
- Treasurer/bookkeeper transition- continuing to transition away from Clergy Financial to Brittni for bookkeeping needs.
- Give to the Max Funds Funds were raised with plan of 50% to be used for building and grounds. Looking at parking lot resurfacing as a short term goal for using funds.

Other:

BSA council Representative – Wendy will fill this role while she is on council- BSA to be notified.

Rockford River Days- Congregational Workshop Tuesday June 20th 7pm - Pam Hoekstra coordinating

Upcoming meeting schedule- will adjust July meeting to July 18th due to 4th of July.

Other items from council – Concern raised from Thousand Hearts Day conflicting with OFLC spring clean up. Wendy has already spoken with Annette Tryon, John Gilb, and Brittni to prevent this in the future.
