Internal Ministries:

1. John Gilb – Building & Grounds Update: John couldn't make it to propose. Shannon went over the proposal by Aaron Hunter and Congregation Members willing to volunteer their time to address the lights in the sanctuary for \$1,720 (strictly material cost). An additional proposal from J Becher and Associates out of Rogers for \$22,000. J Becher and Associates later revised their quote to bring it down to about \$14,000, but Amy confirmed that both of those quotes from J Becher and Associates do not fall within our budget. Council Vote held and passes for Aaron Hunter and fellow congregation members to start process of updating sanctuary lighting. They are planning to start on May 15th.

Administrative/Personnel:

- Pastoral Update: Expo in April was a success, there will be a recognition for all education leaders on May 15th, Pastor noticing a new energy and excitement around the church in the past 6 months.

Finance:

- Treasurer Update: Income in April was \$21,000, which is about \$2,000 short of what was budgeted for April. Council to discuss how we can properly communicate to the congregation how giving needs to increase in order to stay financially healthy. Talked about sharing more detailed financials with congregation members so they are more aware of the monthly financial state of the church. Ideas Include: adding financial info to bulletin, encourage Simply Giving through sermons, help after service to setup, and announcements, and possible promotional gift of a shirt if you sign up for monthly giving.

Other:

- COVID protocol updates for the congregation
 - Discussed letting the pre-packaged communion run out and go back to a pre-covid communion.
- Wendy Gustafson – proposal for project to address storage of non-OFLC materials and overall item inventory.
 - Talked about asking outside groups to remove their personal belongings by May 31st to allow the church to organize and clean over the summer.
- Shannon Sand – proposal for shades for large education room
 - Shannon to present to BNI this summer and ask if the businesses would be willing to donate \$50 per business towards window treatments in the south big room. This would greatly help on utility bills during the summer months when the summer is beating into the big south wing room. Especially now that we have A/C

installed in the south wing. There are 10 total windows and each window treatment would run about \$50-\$60 a window for simple roller shade.
