
Building and grounds is working on getting power run for the nourishing hope truck .

## Financial Report

The below financials reflect cash basis activity where actual cash received is compared to cash paid out for expenses.

Contributions were lower than budget for the month. For the year, we continue to be behind our budget by \$14k.

Expenses were over budget for the month. This is mostly driven by \$3k for our Benevolence payments to ELCA, Riverworks, and Love Inc.

For the year, we continue to run in a deficit at \$10k. Expenses are now on track with budget; therefore, the deficit is due to being behind on our giving.

The cash balance for July 31, 2021 is \$101,081. Designated cash did not change much year over year with Nourishing Hope and Ministry making up most of the balance. We continue to have a kitchen fund, seminary scholarship, social concerns, and technology as our other designated cash funds.
