

Pastoral Call update: Call committee has received 2 candidate names and will begin the interview process.

Pastoral Report – Pastor Bob has been preaching (with Bible study after service,) completing pastoral care calls/visits, and preparing the funeral of Linda Devens.

Finance:

Treasurer update- Funds are stable. Monthly offering for July was \$19,916.

Transition from to new bookkeeping-no further changes this month.

Yeti program- will extend into September to accommodate increase anticipated payroll increase for a new pastor.

Counting Schedule- Increase to twice a month. Counters are signing up for shifts via SignUp Genius.

Vanco update in progress. This is a program that operates Simply Giving and will be required in coming months to continue this service.

<u>Building & Grounds Committee recruitment</u>- John Gilb is resigning effective 10/1.(Thanks John!) Looking to recruit a committee to cover building needs.

<u>Parking lot renovations</u>-Resurfacing bids reviewed. Will plan to resurface/stripe the north parking lot. Goal for completion before Fall Festival. This will be funded from the Give to the Max campaign last fall and a contribution from Nourishing Hope.

<u>Building Security</u> – discussion regarding options for access and improving the system of balancing building security and needs of individual/group access.

Nourishing Hope-will contribute partial funds for parking lot upkeep. They will be adding a line item to their budget to consider building upkeep regarding their services.

VBS-Wonderful week. Many adult volunteers helped things run smoothly. Need to review safety practices re: adult volunteers. Will review/update as needed for next year. **Sunday School/ Engage and Confirm**- Fall enrollment is in progress.

Funeral Process— Discussion of things to update post-Covid costs. Kitchen role will receive a small stipend for each service. While in the call process consider the pastoral funeral pay with increased time spent with families.
